Capitals are the first way to teach children their names. Capitals are the foundation for good handwriting habits. Demonstrate how to start each letter at the top and form each letter correctly. Use the Capital Letter Formation Chart from school.

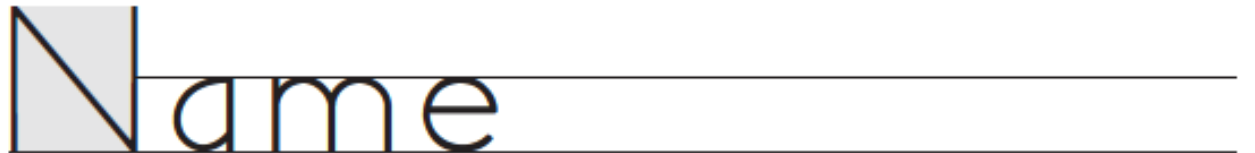

Help Me Write My Name in Title Case

Title case is for children who can already write their names in capitals. The beginning capital fits in a gray block. Small letters fit between the double lines. Tall letters such as **t**, **l**, or **h** go above the double lines and use the top space. Descending letters such as **g**, **j**, or **y** go below the double lines into the bottom space. Demonstrate each letter and wait for the child to imitate you, letter by letter.
