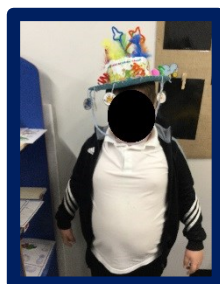
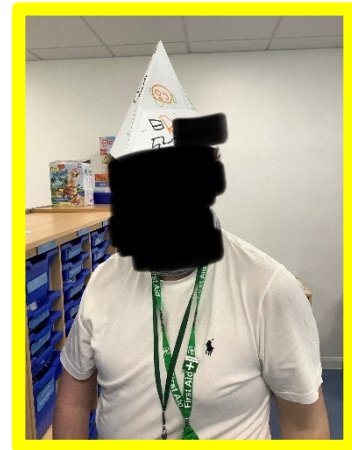


Palm Class

Palm class enjoyed taking part in 'Wear a Hat day'. Just look at these amazing hats the students came in wearing/made at home.

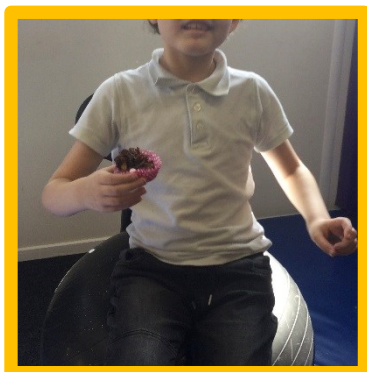
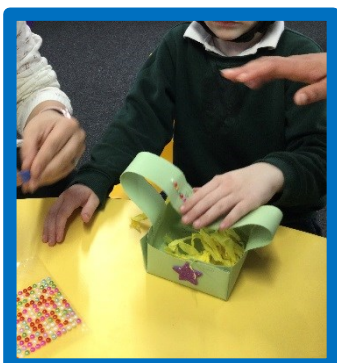
Acorn Class

Saplings Class

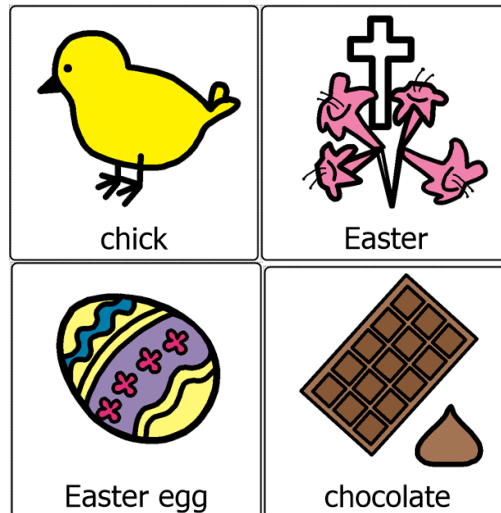
Saplings class made Easter baskets and yummy Easter cakes! What beautifully crafted baskets to carry the delicious cakes home in.
