Dear All,

Just a gentle reminder that should your child, or any member of your family, present with suspected COVID 19 symptoms they must isolate and book a **PCR** test as soon as possible.



This can be booked online via the NHS website www.nhs.uk/coronavirus or ordered by phone on NHS **119**.

Please do not use an LFD home kit to test if you notice suspected symptoms. Always book a **PCR** and isolate until the result is returned.

Key COVID 19 Symptoms:

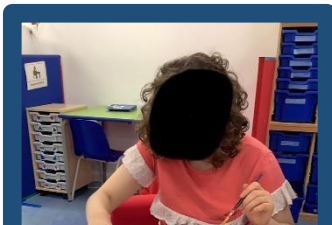
- A new continuous cough

Havering Local Authority are running a consultation on proposed changes to the route 497 bus service and would like to hear your views.

Route 497 currently runs between Harold Wood station and Harold Hill, Gooshays Drive via Gallows Corner Tesco. It was introduced in January 2020. A review of the first year of the service has identified a need to increase ridership of the service, or it could be withdrawn.
